No Appointments Needed For All Other Services.

A variety of adult immunizations are available with some vaccines available at reduced or no cost, depending upon program and grant requirements. For those vaccines with a fee, cash or checks will be accepted for payment.

Tuberculin skin testing is available. Individuals who are being skin tested for Tuberculosis must return on the following Thursday to have the test read and documentation provided.

HIV testing, both "anonymous" and "confidential," is available free of charge at our walk-in clinic .

Sexually Transmitted Infections Clinic Only: Walk-in clinic is available for the testing, diagnosis, and treatment of sexually transmitted infections. All services are free and confidential. Any questions, please call 845.486.3401.
