- Influenza vaccine is recommended for all persons, ages 6 months and older.
- The Dutchess County Department of Health (DCDOH) is able to offer free of charge, inactivated Influenza vaccine.
- Both single dose, thimerosal-free vaccine AND multi-dose formulations containing thimerosal, are available.
- Reminder, since vaccine is provided at no cost, it will need to be given to patients at no cost.
