

DIRECTOR OF OPERATIONS

This is a managerial and technical position responsible for the proper and continued functioning of all Authority water and wastewater facilities. Although general direction is given by board of directors and executive director, ability to exercise independent judgment is necessary. This position supervises subordinate professional, technical and clerical staff. Special requirements include possession of a Grade-2 wastewater treatment plant operator license at time of appointment; plus possession of a Grade-1A water treatment plant operator and Grade-D distribution system operator licenses or eligibility to obtain same within two years of appointment to position. Qualifications include graduation from a regionally accredited or NYS recognized college or university with an Associates' degree in Water and Wastewater Technology or related field, plus five years experience in both water treatment and distribution and sewage collection and treatment, two years of which have been in a supervisory capacity; OR graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma and seven years experience in both water treatment and distribution and sewage collection and treatment, two years of which have been in a supervisory capacity; OR an equivalent combination of training and experience as described above. Compensation package includes health, dental and vision benefits, and participation in NYS Retirement Program.
