### **WATERFRONT DIRECTOR**

**Please note:** These positions are for **students** that are:

Either: (A) Dutchess County residents entering or attending a college/university

Or: (B) non-Dutchess County residents entering or attending a college/university located in Dutchess County.

- *All Candidates must be at least eighteen (18) years of age at time of application*
- *All positions will require fingerprinting. Fingerprint information will be given when a conditional job offer is made.*

Public Works – Parks Division

Wilcox Park

Salary: \$18.29/hr.

This is seasonal supervisory work involving the responsibility for the life and protection of persons swimming or otherwise using the recreational facilities of a pool or beach area. Incumbent may be required to rescue persons experiencing difficulties in the water and administer lifesaving techniques. The incumbent may be required to administer first aid for other injuries suffered in the waterfront area. The position differs from Lifeguard by the addition of record keeping and supervisory responsibilities. Supervision is exercised over seasonal employees. The work is carried out under general direction from the administrative official.

#### **TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:**

Typical work activities for incumbents in this title include those listed below in addition to those typical work activities performed by lower level titles in the series. They are indicative of the level and types of activities performed by incumbents in this title. It is not meant to be all inclusive and does not preclude a supervisor from assigning activities not listed which could reasonably be expected to be performed by an employee in this title. Patrols bathing area during operating hours; patrols open water in a rowboat to prevent drowning accidents; enforces waterfront regulations; supervises lifeguards at park; trains lifeguards in proper lifesaving, first aid, and CPR techniques; submits weekly reports on lifeguards' activities; leads and participates in beach cleaning; provides knowledge of emergency first-aid practices and procedures.

#### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

Possession of a current American Red Cross certified lifeguard training program certificate; CPR certificate; American Heart Association course in basic life support for the Professional Rescuer; and a current American Red Cross Waterfront Lifeguard Module Certificate (beach or waterfront). Waterfront Director's qualifications are the same as lifeguard PLUS two (2) seasons of full-time paid work experience as a lifeguard.
